## SAN ANTONIO REUNION 1979

Here's the final information from Texas.

The reunion starts on Thursday, Sept.13, and loses Sept. 16,1979. It's at the St.Anthony Hotel in downtown San Antonio, Texas. That is just off of I - 37 and 10 minutes from the airport. There are cabs or mini buses (at \$ \$2.50 ea) from the airport.

The St.Anthony is an elegant hotel with an ornate interior style. It is centrally air conditioned, has electric eye doors, and a drive-in garage registration facility. Nearby are fine stores, the Mexican Market and ethnic restaurants.

Rooms are \$52.00 a night, mingle, double or twin. That's a special rate and will apply for those arriving early and departing later than the established meeting dates. The hotel accepts travelers checks, American Express, Visa, Master Charge Diners Club, and Carte Blanc charge cards. You pay when you leave.
